

## Appendix B: 2025 Poverty Guidelines and Lower Living Standard Income Level (LLSIL)

WIOA defines the term “low-income individual” as an individual whose total family annual income does not exceed the higher level of the poverty line or 70% of the LLSIL.

The LLSIL values highlighted in red and marked with an asterisk (\*) indicate areas where the LLSIL is lower than the federal poverty guidelines. In these cases, **the poverty guidelines must be used to determine low-income status.**
